










World's largest internet hub DE-CIX

1 terabit equals a transfer of 230,000 HD quality videos


Apple recently updated the operating system via DE-CIX which led to the new peak!

Minimum Round Trip Time (RTT) in Europe




Germany's Data Center Capital



Data Center Environment

- Most important location for data centers in Germany
- 6 out of the 10 largest data centers in Germany are located in Frankfurt
- In sum there are about 50 data centers in the region of greater Frankfurt





Cyber Security Expertise


