The latest headlines on Germany's economy are positive - neither Brexit nor the new US presidency has had a negative impact on German foreign trade so far:

► Germany leads Europe in EY's Attractiveness Survey 2017. Germany has been voted Europe's most attractive business location in EY's s annual attractiveness survey, joining China and the USA in the global top three business locations.

▶ German economy continues upturn in second quarter. An upturn in Europe's biggest economy is continuing during the second quarter, helped by noticeable rises in private and state spending and by an expansion in industrial production, Germany's economy ministry said in its monthly report on Tuesday.

▶ BDI - Federation of German Industries Quarterly Report II/2017. Strong growth at start of year. Exports surge in first quarter 2017.

► Strong Economy, lack of skilled employees. Results of the Economic Survey conducted by the Association of German Chambers of Commerce & Industry.


