# Facts about German foreign trade

- In 2020, Germany maintained its position as the world's **third largest exporter** (behind China and the US), and **third largest importer** (behind the US and China). **Germany's share of world trade** (exports and imports of goods in USD) increased slightly compared to the previous year, falling to 7.2% (2019: 7.1%). Accounting for 13.1% of global trade, China was able to further extend its lead over the US (10.9%) in first place.
- With a '**degree of openness**' (imports plus exports in relation to GDP) of approximately **87.8%**, Germany continues to be the 'most open' economy of the G7 countries (data for 2019). The **foreign share of value-added in German exports** stood at 20.3% in 2016 (2006: 20.4%). In 2017, over a fifth of domestic **demand** was met by **imports** of goods and services (import dependency rate of 23.1%). In 2017, the **proportion of imports contained in German exports** stood at 39.2% and thus remained unchanged compared with 2016 (39.3%).
- As Germany is highly integrated into the global economy, **employment** in Germany also **relies** heavily on open markets and international trade: some 28% of jobs in Germany are directly or indirectly linked to exports, in manufacturing it is even 56%.
- In 2020, Germany's **most important target market** for trade in goods continued to be **Europe**, which accounted for 67.1% of German exports and 65.3% of German imports. Germany's share of trade with the **EU28** fell in 2019: German **exports** to the EU28 amounted to **57.0%** (2019: 58.5%) and **imports** from the EU28 stood at **55.5%** (2019: 57.2%). The proportion of trade with countries from the **eurozone** dropped in 2019, accounting for **36.6% of exports** and **36.3% of imports** (exports in 2019: 37.2%, imports in 2019: 37.1%).
- Over the course of time, the **BRICS countries have gained in importance** as trading partners for Germany due to their increasing integration into the global economy: between 2005 and 2020, the **share of German exports** going to the BRICS countries rose from 7.0% to 12.0% (2019: 11.6%). **Imports** from the BRICS countries in 2020 amounted to 15.8% (2005: 12.1%, 2019: 15.1%).

- Accounting for 8.6% of German exports, the US remains Germany's **most important export market** in 2020, followed closely by China (8.0%). The **United States' share of German exports declined** slightly compared to 2005 (8.8%), whilst **China's share almost tripled** between 2005 (2.7%) and 2020.
- China's share of German imports also increased significantly in the same period, rising from 6.5% (2005) to 11.4% (2020), while the United States' share saw a slight decline (2005: 6.7%; 2020: 6.6%). **China remains the most important supplier for the German economy** (ahead of the Netherlands and the US).
- Germany's **net foreign demand** contracted slightly in 2020, falling to €193.5 billion; its **share in GDP** remained unchanged, at **5.8%**. As in the previous year, net foreign demand made a negative contribution (-0.9%) to GDP growth (-4.8%).
- In 2020, **Germany's surplus on the trade of goods** declined for the fourth consecutive year, falling to **€179.9 billion** (2019: €224.0 billion). **66.4%** of the overall trade surplus was with the **EU28**, with the **eurozone** accounting for **more than a third (38.1%)** of this. Broken down by country, Germany's **highest surpluses** were with the **US** (+€36.1 billion), **France** (+€34.3 billion), and the **UK** (+€32.0 billion), followed at a distance by **Austria** (+€19.6 billion) and **Switzerland** (+€10.8 billion). Germany's **highest deficits** from trade in goods were with **China** (-€21.0 billion), **Ireland** (-€13.4 billion), **Viet Nam** (-€7.3 billion), **Bangladesh** (-€5.2 billion) and the **Czech Republic and Japan** (both -€3.9 billion).
- In 2020, the **four largest groups of exported goods** made up **almost 50% of German exports**: **vehicles and vehicle parts** (15.5%), **machinery** (14.5%), **chemical products** (9.3%) and **computer/electrical and optical equipment** (9.1%). The main imported goods were **computer/electrical and optical equipment** (11.2%), **vehicles and vehicle parts** (10.8%), **chemical products** (7.8%), **machinery** (7.7%), **electrical equipment** (6.5%) and **pharmaceuticals and similar products** (6.3%).
- According to data provided by the Bundesbank, Germany's **surplus from trade in goods** in 2020 contrasted with a **deficit from trade in services** (-€1.6 billion). According to data supplied by the World Bank, **Germany again ranked third in international trade in services** (exports plus imports) in 2019 (USD 715.9 billion), with the US continuing to be the undisputed leader (USD 1,440.6 billion). According to the OECD, **services in 2016 accounted for 49.4% of the value added by German gross exports** (10.1 percentage points of this were created abroad).
- In 2020, **Germany's current account surplus** declined again, falling to **7.0% of GDP** (2019: 7.5%). **Germany is a member of the European Monetary Union**. The **eurozone's total current account balance** with the rest of the world is the only important balance in a global comparison. As in the previous year, the eurozone's **current-account surplus** in 2020 was **2.3%**.



**Figure 1: Shares of world trade (goods) – Exports and imports on a USD basis**



**Figure 2: Gross domestic product and contributions to growth**


in percentage points

**Figure 3: Germany's net trade by regions (goods)**



**Figure 4: Degree of openness – Exports plus imports in relation to GDP in 2019**



**Figure 5: Share of domestic and foreign value added in German gross final exports**



**Figure 6: Global revenue of trade in services 2019**



**Figure 7: Geographic regions' share of German exports (goods) – 2005 and 2020**



**Figure 8: Selected country groups' share of German exports (goods) – 2005 and 2020**



**Figure 9: Geographic regions' share of German imports (goods) – 2005 and 2020**




**Figure 10: Selected country groups' share of German imports (goods) – 2005 and 2020**

in percent




**Figure 11: Exports of the 10 most important groups in 2020**



**Figure 12: Imports of the 10 most important groups in 2020**




**Figure 13: Exports in main industrial groupings in 2020**
