This requirement applies to all travelers 18 years above. It does not include children below the age of 18 years. Rapid tests are carried out for travellers coming in from southern Africa. For those who test positive, they get a list of selected government approved hotels awhere they must undergo quarantine at their own cost until their PCR-test turns out negative. Incoming travellers from European countries who have not transited or are coming in from countries in Southern Africa are not undergoing testing.	Returning citizens and residents with valid permits will be required to present the negative COVID19 certificate and fill this digital travel surveillance form:  https://bit.ly/3EeEnEH  A random antigen test may be taken by port health officers, depending on risk evaluation of the country of origin	Incoming foreign travelers will be required to present the negative COVID19 certificate and fill this digital travel surveillance form:  https://bit.ly/3EeEnEH The online registration form can be found on Jitenge accessible via Google Play store. Iphone make sure to use Chrome or Firefox when accessing the URL. Upon submission of the digital locator form, a QR code will be sent to your email.  From December 1, travellers originating their travel or transiting through South Africa, Botswana, Zimbabwe, Malawi, Eswatini, Lesotho, Namibia, Israel, Hong Kong, Belgium, Germany, Italy and Czech Republic within the previous 14 days will undergo a free rapid antigen test on arrival for surveillance purposes. If the PCR test is found positive, passengers will need to isolate for 10days a t the GOK approved isolation facilities at their own cost and repeat the PCR test on day 7.
