Employment Law: the only constant is change

The Minister of Workplace Relations and Safety issued a press release and attached Employment Relations Amendment Bill Summary (Summary) yesterday (25 January 2018). This has given an indication of the first set of changes, and the proposed legislation is expected to have its first reading in the first week of February, followed by a select committee process.

The changes to be incorporated in the new amendments outlined in the Summary are:

- Restoration of statutory rest and meal breaks
- Restriction of 90 day trial periods to small medium enterprises
- Reinstatement will be restored as the primary remedy for an unjustified

• Further protections for employees in the "vulnerable industries" identified in the Act.
