TVET Committee Meeting @ ElSewedy Technical Academy in 10th of Ramadan

On 10th of October 2019 the TVET Committee Meeting took place to discuss important aspects such as the new role of the TVET committee, the election of a new chairperson and his/her vices and to site visit ElSewedy Technical Academy. The TVET committee will embark on its new role as a think tank for the TVET activities supported by AHK Egypt, since it is an optimum platform to get all TVET stakeholders on one table to discuss matters of common interest.
