Vestner acquires Engineering Business

The New Zealand subsidiary of Vestner, a German business specializing in elevator construction, has purchased assets of New Zealand Engineering Services. The latter will continue business operations as before but now under the Vestner 'umbrella', effective from 1st April 2016. Vestner was originally founded in Munich, Germany in the 1930s with the production of steam driven rope elevators and has remained a family run company since that time. Read more.

Silver Fern Farms at Edeka

A trial in February has seen SFF-branded venison and lamb sold through 700 stores owned by Germany's largest supermarket EDEKA. The launch into Germany is the biggest to date for New Zealand largest meat cooperative. Branded beef packs will be added in June.
