







LEGAL AND REGULATORY EVOLUTION

APSEI's activities have influenced the legal and regulatory development of the security sector, here are two examples:



In 2013, for the first time, installers had to comply with technical requirements and have qualified technicians



In 2020, alarm systems became subject to mandatory annual maintenance

The Annual Private Security Report informs about all relevant legal developments in the security area and presents a quantitative and qualitative view of the sector

EN 50131 Alarm systems - Intrusion and hold-up systems

EN 62676 Video surveillance systems for use in security applications

EN 60839 Alarm and electronic security systems - Electronic access control systems

- · Facilitates entry into new markets






