# 1st High Level Steering Committee Meeting on Energy and Hydrogen Cooperation between Egypt and Germany

The private sector is indeed the driving part in our operations at the German-Arab Chamber of Industry and Commerce (AHK EGypt). This message was clearly highlighted during our 1st High-Level Steering Committee meeting on Energy and Hydrogen Cooperation between Egypt and Germany, on Sunday 12th March 2023, which was implemented by the German-Chamber of Industry and Commerce in conjunction with the German Agency for International Cooperation (GIZ) GmbH on behalf of the German Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Climate Action (BMWK).

During the roundtable we have witnessed an openness and willingness from both the governmental and private sector from Germany and Egypt, to not only establish further partnerships within the field of hydrogen, but to also start implementing the correct framework, for a sustainable and secure source of energy to life.

The high-profile meeting was attended by H.E. Stefan Wenzel, Parliamentary State Secretary of the BMWK, H.E. Rania A. Al-Mashat, Minister of International Cooperation, H.E. Eng. Tarek El Molla, Minister of Petroleum and Mineral Resources, H.E., Dr. Mahmoud Esmat, Minister of Public Business Sector, Dr. Ahmed Mohamed Mohina, First undersecretary of Research Planning and Authorities at the Ministry of Electricity and Renewables and Stefanie Soerensen, Deputy Head of Development Cooperation at the Embassy of the Federal Republic of Germany in Cairo. The roundtable was moderated by AHK Egypt CEO, Jan Noether, with Ellen von Zitzewitz, the Deputy Head of Division of the BMWK.

Contributing to the discussion were around 70 significant senior officials from German and Egyptian companies operating in the field of green energy such as DAI Infrastruktur Gmbh, INP Egypt LLC, MAN Energy Solutions Egypt, Siemens Energy, SPG Steiner GmBH, thyssekrupp Industrial Solutions Egypt, TÜV NORD, Uniper Global Commodities SE and VNG AG.

While noting Egypt's richness of resources and elements that can be used to produce green energy, the private sector demonstrated a general desire to participate in the transition to green energy.

# **German Due Diligence Law**

The German-Arab Chamber of Industry and Commerce (AHK Egypt) in cooperation with the Federal Embassy of Germany in Cairo, the German Ministry of Economic Cooperation and the Egyptian Commercial Service Office in Berlin organized a hybrid symposium about the implementation of the German due diligence law (Supply Chain Law) and its effects on the Egyptian economy, which was held on Thursday, February 23, 2023, at the German Chamber's headquarters.

The focus lied mainly on the requirements and support services needed for companies to operate the Supply Chain Act, Starting Point and Goal of the legislation and Opportunities and Challenges Facing Egyptian Companies in light of the application of the Due Diligence Law.

#### **EduTech Forum - 2023**

Mona Ayoub, Director of Vocational Education and Training Department at the German-Arab Chamber of Industry and Commerce, (AHK Egypt), was moderating session two "The State of Technical Education Reform and New TVET Initiatives" with the Keynote speaker his excellency Prof. Mohamed Megahed, Deputy Minister of Education & Technical Education and the participation of the panelists Naglaa Nosseir, Telecomegypt (WE) CSR Director, David Nabil, General Manager of NASS Academy, Dr. Dalia Taham, Senior Advisor of Accreditation & Quality Assurance- Workforce Egypt - USAID Funded Project, Ludovic Gelin, Head of Project, Technical Support for the Comprehensive Technical Education Initiative with Egypt (TCTI) - GIZ Egypt, Marwa Mohsen, Chief Programs Development Officer, Ta'heal for VET Skills Excellence, Eng. Ahmed El Saadany, Head of Education & Training - Megaprojects at Siemens Mobility and Dr. Dieter Dohmen, International TVET expert, TEREEE project, CEO of "Research Institute for the Economics of Education and Social Affairs", Germany.

As a result of concerted efforts by the Egyptian government, TVET education in Egypt has seen significant developments over the past few years. TVET has gone from a neglected education and training system to gaining high-level attention and commitment as a major educational system that will contribute to Egypt's overall economic development. From establishing a dedicated Quality Assurance and accreditation authority for TVET called ETQAAN in October 2022, to the transfer of 80% of the Ministry of Education's curricula into competency-based curricula, to strategic partnerships with the private sector, to the introduction of innovative new TVET programs like Smart education, Business technology and FinTech. TVET has many new exciting initiatives that have the potential to drive and transform the sector in Egypt. This session focused on the most important quality assurance mechanisms on institutional and national level as well as the innovative initiatives of the panelists institutions which are contributing to the current developments of the TVET sector in Egypt.

The forum took place on 20th and 21st of February 2023 in Kempinski Royal Maxim hotel.

# ENG. ALAA KAMAL, MANAGING DIRECTOR, INP EGYPT

Engineer Alaa Kamal holds a bachelor's degree in civil engineering from Alexandria University in 1984 and holds a diploma in Operational Safety. Kamal started his career through Abu Qir Fertilizers Company in Alexandria, before taking on several local and international positions. He is currently the managing director of INP Deutschland – INP Egypt LLC since 2016.

Kamal speaks to Connect Online-AHK Egypt's monthly E-Newsletter, in an exclusive interview about his professional development at INP and the future ambitions INP has for Egypt to reach the green economy.



# WHAT WAS THE PATH YOU TOOK TO GET TO WHERE YOU ARE TODAY AS MANAGING DIRECTOR OF INP EGYPT?

I had worked for various international corporations in Egypt, the Middle East, and Africa as a site construction engineer, including UHDE Germany, Frucon construction USA, Dillingham ABB USA, London Mining UK, Jacob USA, and INP Germany. Over this road I have had a lot of ups and downs, but each one has made me stronger, given me a lesson for my future work, and helped me get back up with more experience and dedication.

AS MANAGING DIRECTOR, YOU CARRY A LOT OF RESPONSIBILITIES IN YOUR DAILY WORK LIFE. HOW DO YOU FIND THE BALANCE BETWEEN THE DEMANDS OF WORK AND YOUR PERSONAL FULFILMENT?

While it's one of the trickiest questions, family will always come first. Although, weekends and seasonal holidays are greatly welcomed, and I spend them largely with my family. Unfortunately, there are also numerous excuses due to unplanned business meetings and last-minute changes in plans.

#### HOW DO YOU MEASURE SUCCESS AND OVER WHAT TIME FRAME?

For me, success entails my staff being content in their positions and giving the company their utmost as if it were their own business.

WHAT WORD OF ADVICE CAN YOU GIVE TO THE YOUNGER GENERATION WHO IS STARTING THEIR CAREERS?

My advice would be as simple as like what you do, and do what you like.

WHAT ARE YOUR GROWTH AND EXPANSION PLANS FOR INP EGYPT FOR THE NEXT 5 YEARS?

We have an ambitious plan and aim to be superior in industrial construction and project management, especially in green hydrogen and ammonia.

#### WHAT DO YOU FEEL IS INP BIGGEST STRENGTH?

Our greatest strength and asset is a fantastic staff that works as a team and values family. Accordingly, we believe in teamwork, so we do our best to keep our team dedicated to the company and make an effort to increase our staff's talents through training and team building exercises.

DESCRIBE INP'S SOCIAL CONNECTION WITH THE EGYPTIAN COMMUNITY IN FURTHER DETAIL.

Our CSR objectives include our societal duty, which is well acknowledged. In collaboration with the AfriZert organisation, we are providing internship opportunities for German and Egyptian students. Moreover, during holy days, we also give food donations to those in need.

AS A GERMAN COMPANY, DO YOU FEEL YOU HAVE A RESPONSIBILITY TO GET EGYPT CLOSER TO ITS GOAL OF A GREEN TRANSITION? IN WHICH WAYS?

Of course, it is the essential objective for all German and Egyptian businesses, not just for us. The main objective for our kids' future is to protect the environment. As a German enterprise, it is our duty to supply Egypt with cutting-edge technology for the decarbonization of new industrial facilities as well as technology that is environmentally friendly for newer ones.

#### WHAT OBSTACLES DOES INP FACE IN THEIR DEVELOPMENT IN EGYPT?

I'll call them challenges rather than impediments or obstacles; these include market stability, the availability of foreign currency, and investment, above all.

INVESTING IN A RENEWABLE FUTURE WHAT ARE THE POTENTIAL FOR INVESTING IN RENEWABLE ENERGY IN EGYPT UNDER THIS HEADING, AND WHICH ARE THE MOST PROMINENT PROJECTS IN WHICH INP EGYPT IS INVOLVED?

Sun, wind and desert these are our new Energy (oil and gas) resources, in which we need to heavily invest in, specifically in PV, CSP, pump & storage, Molten salt and batteries. We, at INP Egypt are developing 100 MWH green Hydrogen and Ammonia, utilizing the green power from the solar and wind energy.

# IS THERE ANY COOPERATION BETWEEN EGYPT AND GERMANY IN GREEN HYDROGEN AND WHAT IS THE POTENTIAL ROLE OF INP EGYPT?

The partnership is actually still in the planning stages, due to the minimal effort made by a few firms. Egypt still has to publish the final hydrogen plan; depending on that, German involvement could be realized. At the implementation stage of engineering, building, and project management, as well as later on during the operation and maintenance of the plants, INP Egypt may play a significant part in this cooperation.

# Wintershall Dea Annual Press Conference 2023

2022 was an extremely challenging year, which brought significant change for Wintershall Dea.

Let me take you through some of the key numbers for 2022. We realized an EBITDAX of 5.9 billion Euros and adjusted net income of 0.9 billion Euros. We achieved free cash flow of 2.5 billion Euros and ended the year with net debt of only 1.3 billion Euros and a cash position of 3.1 billion Euros. So, we have a strong balance sheet, also confirmed by our credit ratings which stayed unchanged.

This performance was only possible because of the hard work of our teams, who have stayed focused on producing much-needed energy in difficult times. I thank #teamwintershalldea for their commitment, dedication and performance during that extraordinary year 2022.

We are still one of the largest independent E&P companies in Europe. With production of 321,000 barrels of oil equivalent per day in 2022, again, excluding Russia. We are internationally diversified. Active in 11 countries worldwide, with a focus on core operations in Norway, Argentina, Egypt and Germany; on growth in Mexico and Algeria; and with optionality in other countries.

We look to the future as a resilient and more focused company. Nonetheless, there will be further changes to our business. In light of our changed portfolio, we will take a critical look at costs and how we operate in the coming year. We have to stay competitive.

We have two strategic priorities. Moderate growth for our E&P business, aiming for 350,000 to 400,000 barrels of oil equivalent per day in the medium term. And building up our carbon management and hydrogen business.

Firstly, let's look at moderate growth for our E&P business. We are strengthening our gas-weighted portfolio. We are geographically diversifying. We will do so with focused exploration, and value-accretive M&A.

In 2022, we made significant progress. We brought additional production online, at a time when it was sorely needed. Our operated Nova oil field came on stream in late July. In addition, the Njord field restarted production in December.

Our development pipeline is filled. In Norway we submitted eight development plans last year, two operated, and in Argentina we took the Final Investment Decision for the Fénix gas field.

In Norway, we participated in discoveries with a combined estimated gross volume of 88 to 286 million barrels of oil equivalent recoverable. And we secured eleven new exploration licenses, three as operator. In Egypt, we found gas at East Damanhour, and added a new exploration block to our portfolio, the North West Abu Qir block.

Looking at M&A, we made a step forward for our growth plans. In Algeria, we increased our stake in the Reggane Nord gas project. In Mexico, we entered the producing Hokchi oil project, adding cost- and emissions-efficient barrels to our portfolio.

Bringing additional production online, a full development pipeline, exploration and M&A successes: there were a lot of positive developments even in this year.

Our second strategic priority is carbon management and hydrogen. We see significant markets developing for carbon capture and storage – CCS – and for low-carbon hydrogen. We see no route to net zero without them, and experts agree.

Our goal is to build a carbon management and hydrogen business to potentially abate 20 to 30 million tonnes of CO2 a year by 2040. Equivalent to sixty per cent of CO2 emissions from the huge German steel industry. These are significant numbers.

In just days, CO2 will be taken offshore Denmark and injected underground into the Nini-West reservoir. We are confident that this test injection will be the prelude to full-scale CO2 storage at Nini West from 2025/26.

This project – Project Greensand – is just one of a cluster of projects we are driving forward in the North Sea. In 2022: We secured our first CO2 storage license in Norway, the Luna license. We established the NOR-GE project: the goal of which is to connect German industry with Norwegian CO2 storage. We are working on a hydrogen and CO2 transport hub at Wilhelmshaven in Germany.

Together these projects have the potential to make a real difference: Connecting Germany, Norway, and Denmark. Decarbonizing German and European industry, with safe offshore CO2 storage. Creating new value chains.

Achieving it will mean a significant evolution of our business. We are on track. Wintershall Dea is in transition: from the leading independent European gas and oil company to become a leading independent European gas and carbon management company.

2022 was a tough year. But we will move forwards. We do so with a clear strategy: Moderate growth in E&P. Building up our carbon management and hydrogen business.

Two goals that are clearly aligned with the world's great energy challenges: Ensuring security of supply while tackling climate change.

Wintershall Dea is part of the solution. That drives our team forward.


