






Purchasing power in Germany: Bavaria ahead


Grants For Investments

"GRW Cash Grants" for production site set-up or service location development

Eligible costs refer to either **the investmentrelated capital expenditure** for new buildings, equipment and machinery or **personnel costs** during the establishment phase of a new business.

The maximum amount of support:

Company	small	medium- sized	large
C-incentive regions	30%	20%	10%
D-incentive regions	20%	10%	0%


