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

Taheal Delegation Trip_SZ

The German-Arab Chamber of Industry and Commerce arranged a study tour for our partners from Taheal – تأهيل – for Vet Skills Excellence, in participation of key figures from the Egyptian Ministry of Education and Technical Education MoETE وزارة التربية والتعليم المصرية.

The study tour aimed to establish partnerships, identify academic providers, and create platforms for cooperation between business and education in Egypt's tourism/hospitality, ICT and industrial sectors. The Egyptian participation was represented in Dr. Dalia Ibrahim, Chairwoman of the Board, Shoroke H. Zedan, CEO & Managing Director, Dr. Amr Bosila, Head of the Central Administration for the Development for Technical Education and the Director of the Operation and Management Unit for Applied Technology schools at MoETE; Dr. Shaimaa Mamdouh, Deputy Director of the Operation and Management Unit for Applied Technology schools and Mona Abdallah Ayoub, TVET Department Director at AHK Egypt.

The agenda of the tour included meetings, presentations, and visits to various organizations and institutions in Berlin, Stuttgart, Pforzheim, Calw, and Bonn. During the tour, the delegation had the opportunity to meet with key stakeholders such as the DIHK, Bundesagentur für Arbeit (the Federal Employment Agency), (Bundesinstitut für Berufsbildung - BIBB), and (the German Office for International Cooperation in Vocational Education and Training - GOVET). The tour also involved visiting different vocational schools in Germany to gain insights into curricula creation and vocational training.

Germany Expands its Reliance on Hydrogen Imports

In accordance with the targets established by the Energy Working Group in May 2023, the German-Arab Chamber of Industry and Commerce is in communication with German firms to establish bilateral relationships between the two countries with the aim of boosting the hydrogen industry. In collaboration with the German Energy Agency (dena), the Chamber has partnered to send a representative to attend a conference on Germany's energy transition. This initiative aims to facilitate the exchange of knowledge about Germany's energy industry.

Germany's Energy Targets:

Germany has committed to becoming the first EU country and the world's first to achieve carbon neutrality by 2045. This involves electrolyzer production capacities of 6GW by 2024 and 40GW by 2030. These targets align with the EU Commission's goal for EU countries to achieve carbon neutrality by 2050, with an electrolyzer production capacity of 100 GW by 2030. To be able to achieve these targets, Germany will need its imports to be the only source of hydrogen as well as have 50TWh of hydrogen until 2025 so it can utilize it at its refineries, fertilizers, steel, SAF, and chemicals.

Germany's heavy reliance on hydrogen imports, is due to the high demand for additional renewable which Germany cannot locally produce, due to its lack of that imports are the only source of hydrogen.

Germany's Hydrogen Strategy:

The German parliament is currently having ongoing discussion about a new import strategy, which should be released at the end of 2023. For Germany to fully utilize its potential within the hydrogen industry, a reliable framework with certain conditions needs to be created, such as developing mechanisms should be developed for industries classified as "non-energy-intensive" to support their transition to hydrogen.

The Hydrogen Pipeline Network:

The federal government is pushing ahead with plans for a 9,700-kilometer-long hydrogen pipeline network, to be completed by 2032. The hydrogen core network, which the Ministry of Economic Affairs and the Association of Transmission System Operators (FNB Gas) showed in a line map, is intended to connect ports, industry, storage and power plants and will get an investment of 19.8 billion euros.

The financial details of the core network are yet to be decided by the federal cabinet; however, there are expectations that it will receive support from the private sector. The state aims to make advance payments over the next few years to facilitate the ramp-up of the hydrogen economy.

H2 Global: The Future of German's Hydrogen Industry:

To facilitate the start of the green hydrogen industry and its international market ramp-up, the H2Global Foundation was established in June 2021. The Federal Government is providing a total of €900 million for this project.

H2Global is underpinned by the notion of the 'double-auctions model', which aims to bridge the gap between the high prices at which hydrogen is currently being traded on in the global market with the lower prices at which it can be sold at in a regional level.

During the international auction for the purchase of green hydrogen or its derivatives, which is held on behalf of a subsidiary of the H2Global Foundation. The best offer wins and receives a 10-year long-term contract on the demand side and a 1-year contract on the supply side. This model will ensure that the price is based on the annual increase, thus the gap between the supply and demand will decrease.



4th G20 Investment Summit 2023

Our CEO, Jan Noether, took part on November 20, 2023, at the 4th G20 Investment Summit 2023: German Business and the Compact with Africa Countries, organized by the Sub-Saharan Initiative of German Business (#SAFRI) in Berlin.

The German Chancellor, Olaf Scholz, along with other government representatives from Africa and Germany, participated in the 1st panel discussion of the summit, discussing the potential economic benefits that Africa can provide to the local supply chain and the opportunities presented by the African free trade areas for collaboration with German companies.

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Everything You need to Know about ELEFAND

The German Embassy in Egypt has created a new database for German nationals abroad, regardless of the country they are in.

Whether they are abroad for vacation, a business trip, or for several months, German nationals are encouraged to sign up on ELEFAND, the crisis prevention list. By signing up to the list, registered individuals will help guide them to handle any emergency or crisis, whether it is a natural disaster or other.

Thore Neuman, Director of Legal and Consular affairs and Tobias Krause, Deputy Head of Mission from the German Embassy in Egypt gave us today an introduction about ELEFAND and engaged with our guests in a dynamic discussion with the aim of mainly utilizing this new crisis management system.

It is also important to note that ELEFAND can also be utilized by companies in Egypt who are planning to host German guests. By encouraging them to sign up before their arrival in the country, to ensure that they have access to support them throughout their stay abroad.






BUSINESS CONVERSATION

KHALED EL SHAER, CEO - BLUE SKY TRAVEL




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
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
