

New Zealand is "Country of the Year" at BIOFACH China



Although the main focus of the GNZCC is promoting trade between Germany and New Zealand, we often provide support and expertise for NZ trade show participation in other locations – one recent example was at BIOFACH China, in Shanghai, the largest organic expo in Asia, organised by Nurnberg Messe. This year New Zealand was selected as "Country of the Year" at BIOFACH China and the GNZCC assisted the Organics Exporters Association in organising a New Zealand Pavilion, which we are pleased to report won the "Organisation Award". With the Kapa Haka group performing at the opening ceremony and at various times around the pavilion, a lasting impression was made.

The German Chamber (AHK) World Business Outlook



In May 2018, the seventh "AHK World Business Outlook" showed that global economic growth is developing, despite global crisis and trade policies. Companies based in New Zealand reported they have confidence in the future however skilled labour shortages are of major concern.

* The AHK World Business Outlook is based on a regular survey of member companies from the German Chambers of Commerce, Delegations and representative offices (AHK). It captures the feedback from more than 5,100 German companies, branches and subsidiaries worldwide, as well as companies with close relationships to Germany.

Free Trade Agreement between the EU and New Zealand

On 22 May 2018, the Council of the European Union adopted the decision authorising the opening of negotiations for a Free Trade Agreement between the EU and New Zealand.

In 2017 the EU and New Zealand entered into a partnership agreement which contains a number of economic and trade cooperation rules. MORE..

New Customs law good news for everyone

The new Customs and Excise Act will enable Customs to adapt to a changing world and is good news for everyone in New Zealand, the Acting Comptroller of Customs, Christine Stevenson, said today.

Some of the changes include:

- A new valuation rulings service to help remove uncertainty for importers when they are unsure of the value of goods.
- The ability for businesses to store records offshore or in the cloud. This aligns with modern business practice and with Inland Revenue.


