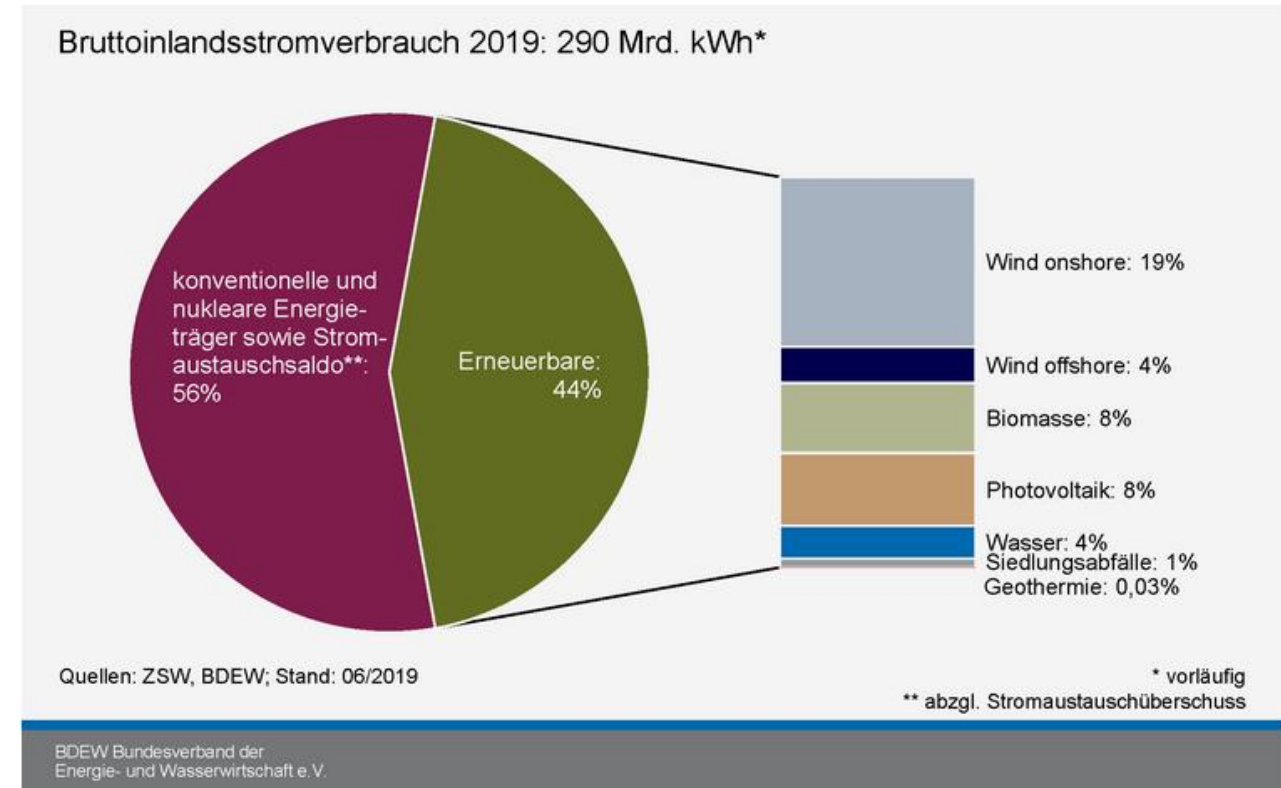
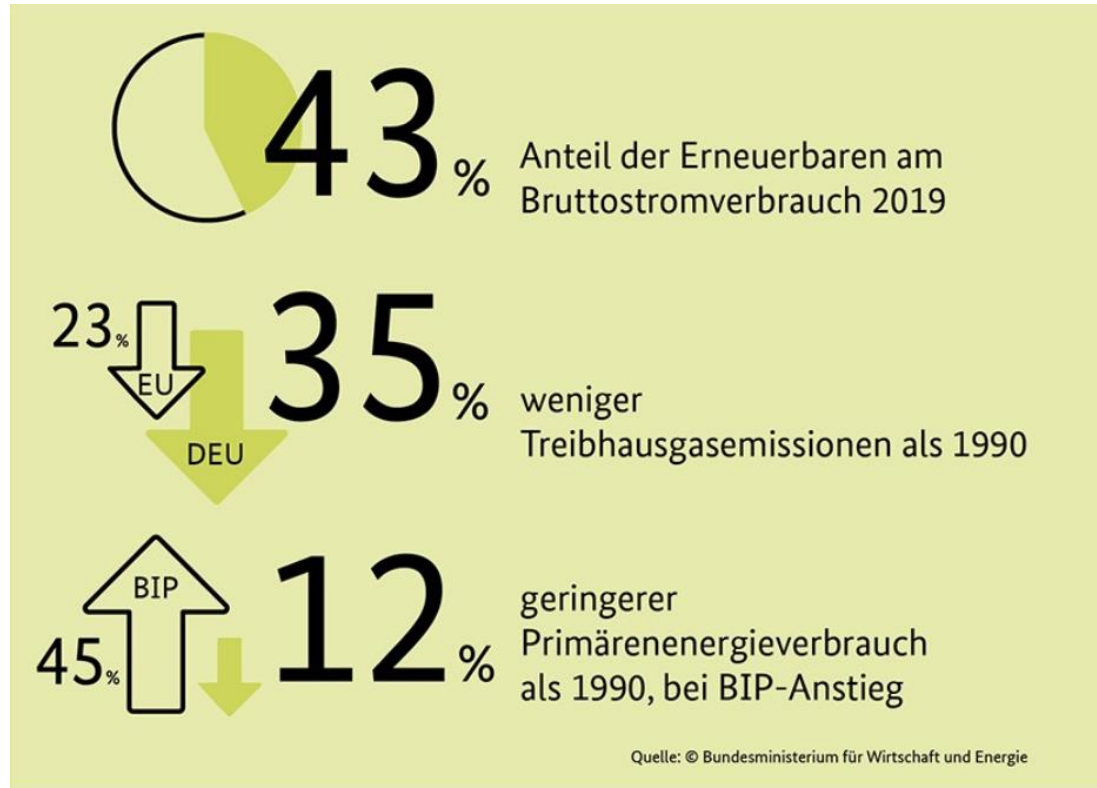

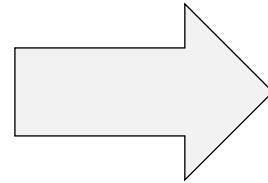

Actual numbers and percentage of renewables



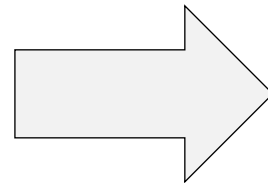
Aims in Germany

(vs. 2008)

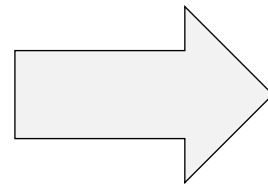
2050: **-50%**
