

## First German-Angolan Mining Roundtable

*Luanda, 22th of November 2019*

Angola is seen as an investor friendly mining destination and is looking into a bright future in the mining industry. Angola was listed in the top five best investment destinations in Africa, ranking currently second after Ethiopia (Investment Risks Africa Report 2019). All foreigners are now free to repatriate up to five million dollars without the authorization of the Angolan Central Bank. In addition, Angola approved a new mining code which is comparable to modern mining codes worldwide.

The African country is the world's 5<sup>th</sup> largest producer of diamonds and plans to double diamond production to 14 Million carats during the next 4 years. Further opportunities are lying in the area of iron ore and gold. The study at the Kassala Kitungo iron ore project indicates total resources of 217 Million tons with an annual production estimate of 6 million tons per annum and the first phase of the Mpopo Gold Project is expected to produce about 22.000 ounce per annum. In addition, Angola holds export opportunities and access to markets (especially to the copper belt in Zambia and the DRC) with its long coastline at the Atlantic Ocean.

- 1. Development infrastructure, transport and energy in Angola**
- 2. Health and Safety in the Angolan mining industry**
- 3. The role of industry 4.0 in the Angolan mining industry**
