EFE-Egypt signing ceremony



In the context of the German Arab Chamber for Industry and Commerce (GACIC) partnerships, a new collaboration was initiated with EFE-Egypt (Education for employment) aiming at providing excellent preparation modules for TVET students and job seekers that empowers them to enter the labor market with the necessary skills and competencies, bridging the gap between their education outcomes and the requirements of the labor market.

The signing of the memorandum of understanding took place on 12th of April, at EFE-Egypt premises in Cairo. Signatories were Mr. Jan Noether, CEO of the German-Arab chamber and Ms. Nora Abu El Seoud, CEO of EFE-Egypt.

The partnership will include joint activities and events between both organizations such as job fairs and joint marketing and promotional activities that target TVET students and job seekers, providing them with soft skills trainings and supporting them with placements.

Webinar: Gender inclusion in nontraditional jobs



Under the title “Inclusion and Non-traditional Jobs”, the TVET committee has held a discussion on the inclusion of females in male dominant sectors. The webinar took place on 4th of April, with the attendance of 30 participants providing a platform for speakers to present the female inclusion in two important sectors: automotive and construction. The committee’s target was to stimulate ideas in the TVET sector about such an important aspect.

Eng. George Sedky Samuel, representing GB Auto, discussed the representation of females in the automotive sector, shedding the light on the issue of low participation especially due to the cultural obstacles. GB Auto with the cooperation of the Ministry of Education and Technical Education address this issue through accepting more female applicants in Applied Technology Schools especially in fields such as mechanical and technical repairs.

On the other hand, Dr. Amr Abdel-Kawy representing NASS Academy, who is the service provider of Talaat Mustafa Group discussed the participation of females in the construction sector, emphasizing on the idea that the applied technology system can influence social change. He believes that the issue of gender inequality in the vocational sector is a social problem and should be addressed with consideration to its complexity.

Dr. Amr Bosiala, representing the unit for Applied Technology Schools at the Ministry of Education and Technical Education was among the honorable panel members.

GB Midterm Examination conducted in 23rd of March – 8th of April 2021

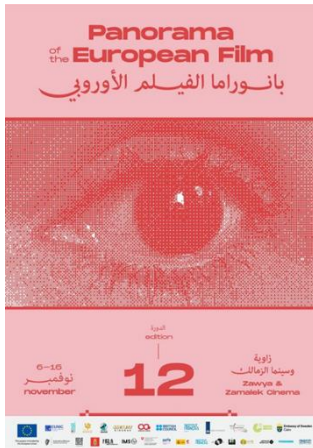


The midterms exams for GB Schools took place during late March and early April. The practical exams took place in three schools in Kafr El-Zayat, Imbaba, and Alexandria. For Kafr El-Zayat the exams were on the 23rd, 24th and 25th of March, followed by Imbaba on the 28th, 29th, 30th and 31st and finally by Alexandria on the 4th, 5th and 6th of April. On the other hand, the theoretical exams were conducted in all three schools on the 8th of April in parallel, in a process that was both strict and organized.

The exams included 377 apprentices from the three schools, and about 50 examiners were involved over the examination period at the three schools.

TVET Webinar: Technical education in creative industries webinar



On 18th of March 2021, the German Arab Chamber of Industry and Commerce hosted a webinar under the title “Vocational Education in Egypt and the Creative Industries”. The webinar provided a platform for three projects that connected vocational training and creative industries to showcase their work, achievement and potential.

The first presentation by Mr. Walid Qorish for “Egyskills Career Solutions” funded by the European Union in collaboration with European Union National Institutes for culture (EUNIC). The project aimed at providing knowledge and education for creative industries in Egypt, bridging the gap between the skills and the creative industries in Egypt demand.

This was followed by a presentation by Ms. Lara Pook, Project Assistant at Goethe Institute, for the “Euro-Egyptian cultural program 2019-2020”. The program targeted creative actors, individuals and organizations, and emerging artists through three interrelated cultural activities: film and music festivals, radio platform and an open call for small and medium grants for cultural activities. The program will be extended in 2021-2022, including more activities such as capacity building, in addition to expanding geographically to reach more cities such as the Canal cities and Siwa.

The third and the final presentation was by Mr. Mahmoud Diab, Advisor for the Deputy Minister of Education and Technical Education, discussing the transformation of Technical Education in Egypt under the title “Technical education 2.0”. The transformation covers five main pillars: Quality, Relevance, Teachers, Schools, and Image of Tech

nical Education.

The presentations were followed by a round of Q&A, where the 25 participants were engaged in following up with questions and comments.

المجال الأول: تكنولوجيا المعلومات:

التدريب المهني في هذا المجال في ألمانيا يشمل اربع تخصصات مختلفة كالآتي:

- تحليل البيانات والعمليات
- الشبكات الرقمية
- تكامل الأنظمة
- تطوير التطبيقات

المجال الثاني: الصيانة الميكانيكية

التدريب المهني في هذا المجال في ألمانيا يشمل التنظيم والتحكم في عمليات الإنتاج، التأكد من أن الآلات ومحطات الإنتاج جاهزة للتشغيل، إنشاء محطات إنتاج كاملة أو آلات، ويشمل تخصص تكنولوجيا الإنتاج في هذا المجال، تركيب وتحويل الآلات والتحكم في عمليات الإنتاج. أيضاً صيانة وإصلاح مرافق الإنتاج والأنظمة التقنية.
