THE PROJECT...

is a pilot project funded by the Federal Ministry for Economic Affairs and Energy (BMWi) and implemented by the Federal Employment Agency (BA) and the DIHK Service GmbH. The project started in January 2020 and will end in June 2023.

GOALS

The project partners develop and apply a **practicable and transferable process** to attract qualified specialists in CCI* professions from non-EU countries for companies in Germany. This approach is implemented in close cooperation with the German Federal Employment Agency, regional Chambers of Commerce and Industry (IHK) and German Chambers of Commerce Abroad (AHK).
