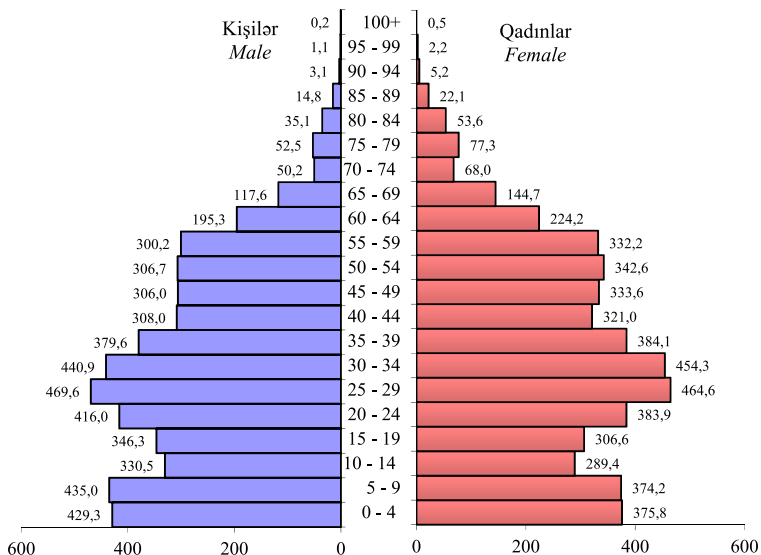

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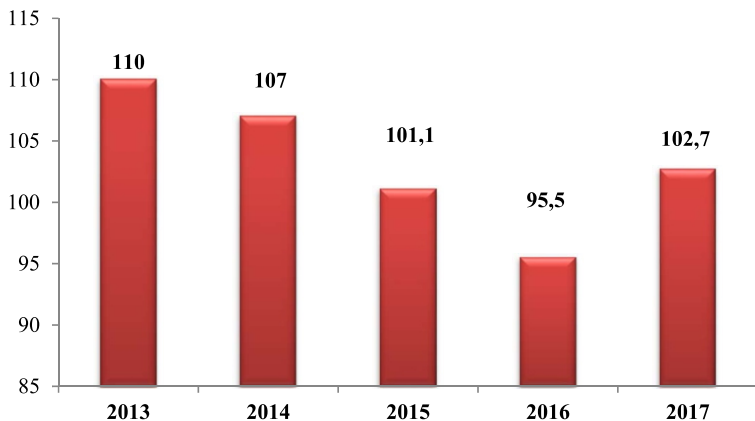

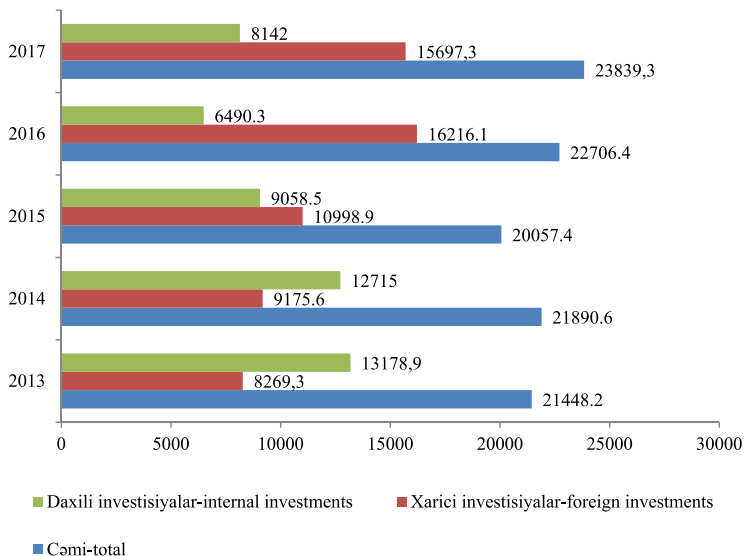

in per cent to the previous year*

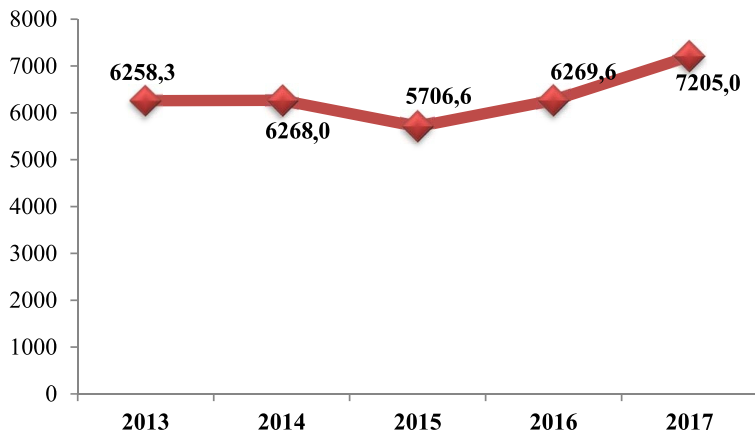

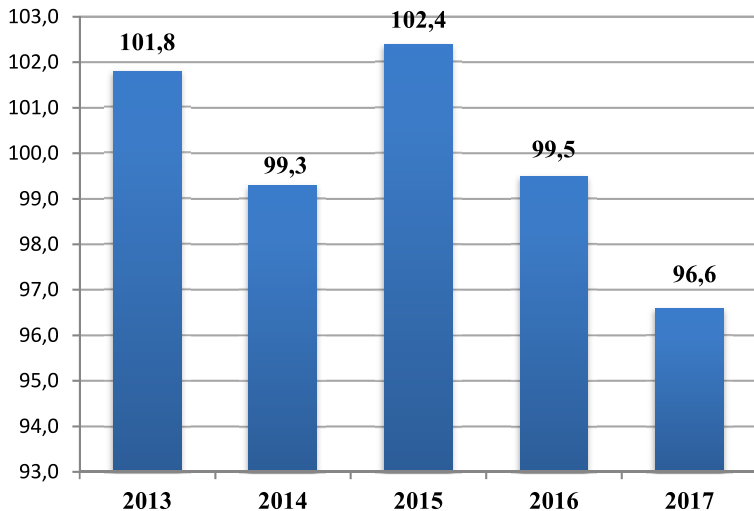
*Investment to economy of the country

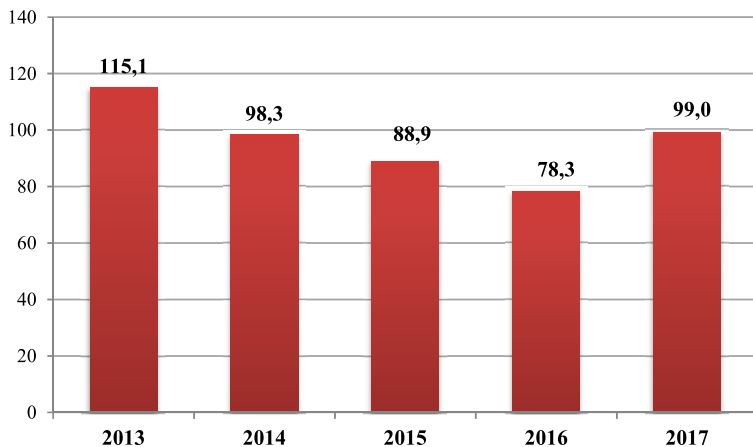
**Əhalinin hər nəfərinə düşən ümumi

in manats*



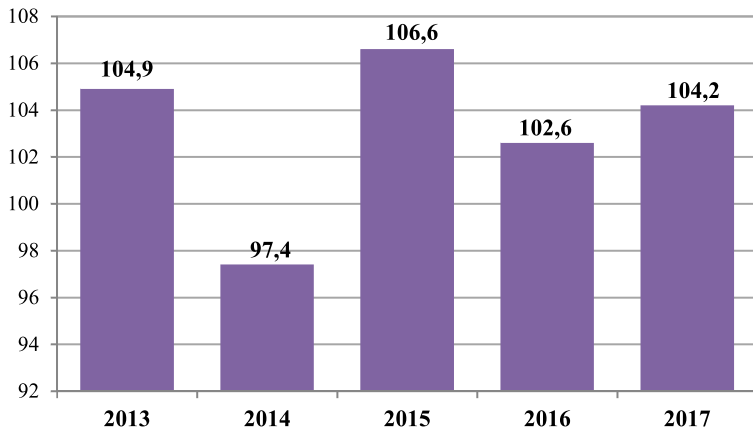

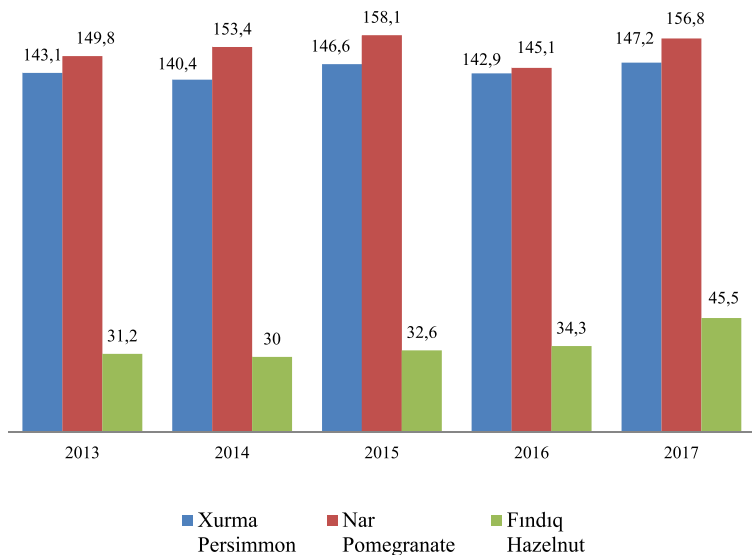

Investment, in per cent to the previous year



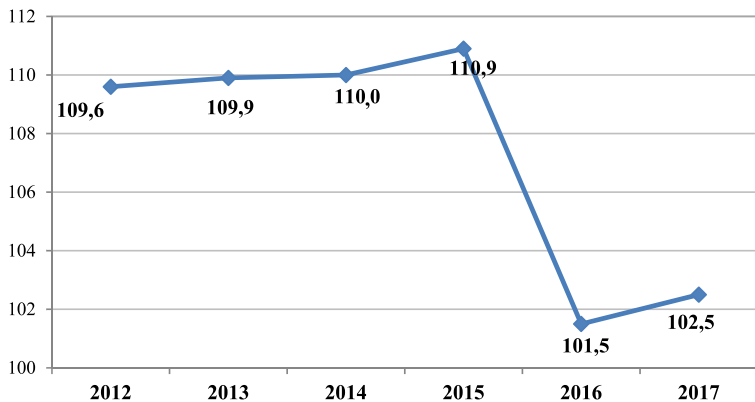

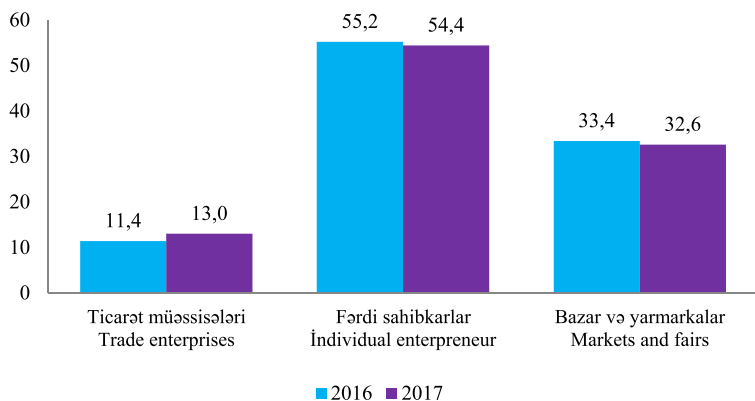

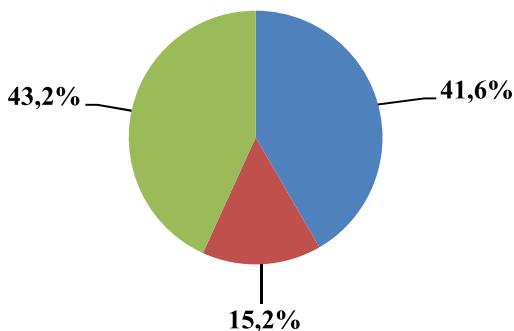

(as percent of total)***

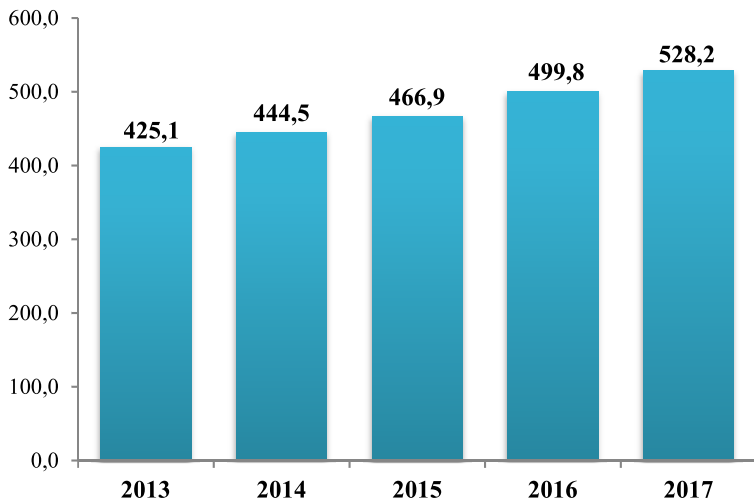

in 2017*



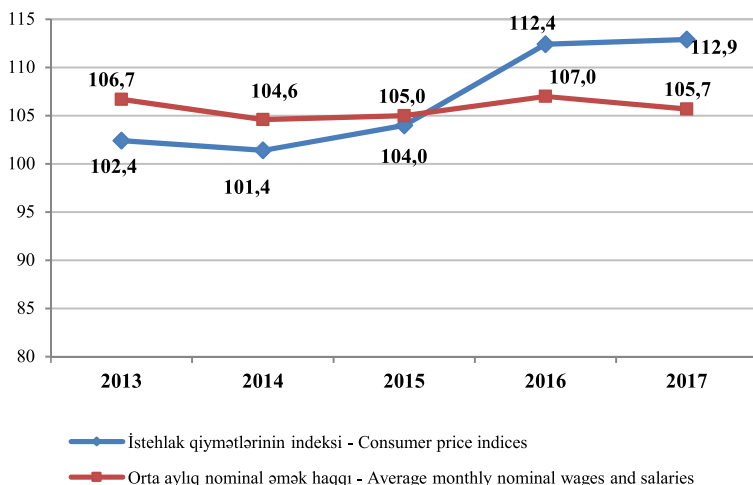

salaries of employees, manats*

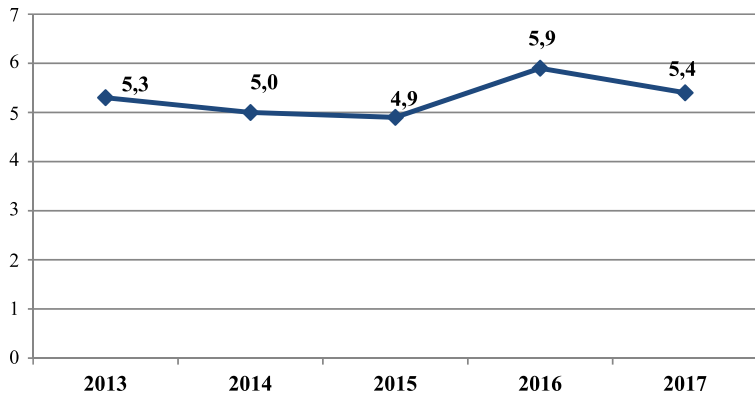

Political system

Head of the State: President

The President is elected by secret vote for seven-years term. In April 11, 2018 **Ilham Haydar Aliyev** was elected as the President of the Republic of Azerbaijan, after acquiring of votes of 3 394 898 persons or 86,02% of electorates in the elections.

The Legislative Authority of the Republic of Azerbaijan is implemented by the National Assembly (Milli Mejlis) of the Republic of Azerbaijan. The National Assembly of the Republic of Azerbaijan consist of 125 deputies. The fourth call an election to the National Assembly was held on November 1, 2015.
