Matthew is the Programme Director of the capital refurbishment programmes at Kāinga Ora. These programmes include the upgrade and reset of existing state housing to meet or exceed current code.

Matthew's tenure at Kāinga Ora has seen him work to progress the Kāinga Ora Retrofit programme from an initial pilot stage with an annual turnover of fewer than 70 projects locally to over 700 projects nationally. As well, Matthew has helped to evolve maintenance projects in multiunit complexes into more comprehensive refurbishments to improve the performance and condition of these buildings for the occupants.

Matthew has both a degree in Arts and in Building Science and is interested in the production of programme outcomes that satisfy a range of outcomes, including economic, social, environmental and cultural to be able to build strategic and sustainable ways of working that also work for the communities they are delivered in. He is an advocate for improvement in our built environment and currently sits on the Steering Committees for the Kāinga Ora Mould Project, the Health Outcomes Project Evaluation project and is a member of the Kāinga Ora Rainbow Network Governance Group.
