4. Purposes and legal bases of the processing

6. Your rights

If the legal prerequisites exist, you can request the deletion or limitation of the processing and appeal against the processing (Articles 17, 18 and 21 DSGVO).

In case of contradiction to the processing of your data, the membership relation would end.

Because the data processing is based on a contract but data processing is carried out automatically, you may have the right to transfer data (Art. 20 DSGVO).
